## What is this product?

**TYPE**  
The product is a sub-fund of Universe, The CMI Global Network Fund, an Undertaking for Collective Investment in Transferable Securities (UCITS) incorporated as a variable capital investment company (SICAV) under the laws of Luxembourg.

**TERM**  
The Sub-Fund is established for an unlimited duration. However the Board of Directors may decide to close this product under certain circumstances.

**OBJECTIVES**  
The Sub-Fund aims to increase the value of your investment over the long term by actively outperforming the MSCI Asia Pacific ex-Japan Index. The Sub-Fund normally invests mainly in a diversified portfolio of shares of companies (of all sizes) located in countries that border the Pacific Ocean (excluding Japan) that are part of the MSCI Asia Pacific ex-Japan Index.

In choosing investments, the investment manager first screens out companies with undesirable characteristics, then uses in-depth research about individual companies to assemble a portfolio.

The Sub-Fund may use Derivatives for efficient portfolio management, to manage risks or to seek investment gains.

The Sub-Fund may hold ancillary liquid assets.

You may redeem shares of the Sub-Fund on any business day in Luxembourg.

The Sub-Funds does not promote environmental or social characteristics, or has as objective sustainable investment. Please refer to the Prospectus for more information about the Sustainable Finance Disclosure Regulation ("SFDR") classification of the Fund.

These shares are accumulation shares. Income and capital gains are included in the NAV calculation.

## What are the risks and what could I get in return?

### Risk indicator



The risk indicator assumes you keep the product for 5 years.

## What happens if FundSight S.A. is unable to pay out?

FundSight S.A. is not making any payment to you in relation to this SICAV and you would still be paid in case of a default from FundSight S.A.

The Sub-Fund's assets are held with CACEIS Bank, Luxembourg Branch and are segregated from the assets of other sub-funds of the SICAV. The assets of the Sub-Fund cannot be used to pay the debts of other sub-funds of the SICAV.

## What are the costs?

The person advising on or selling you this product may charge you other costs. If so, this person will provide you with information about these costs and how they affect your investment.

### Costs over time

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. These amounts depend on how much you invest, how long you hold the product and how well the product does. The amounts shown here are illustrations based on an example investment amount and different possible investment periods.

We have assumed:

- In the first year you would get back the amount that you invested (0 % annual return). For the other holding periods we have assumed the product performs as shown in the moderate scenario.

(\*) This illustrates how costs reduce your return each year over the holding period. For example it shows that if you exit at the recommended holding period your average return per year is projected to be 5.3% before costs and 4.7% after costs.

We have classified this product as 4 out of 7, which is a medium risk class.

This rates the potential losses from future performance at a medium level, and poor market conditions could impact our capacity to pay you.

## How long should I hold it and can I take my money out early?

### Recommended holding period: 5 years.

The recommended holding period was chosen to provide a consistent return less dependent on market fluctuations.

Redemptions are possible every Dealing Day (a Business Day, i.e. any full day on which banks are open for business both in Luxembourg and London). All redemption requests must be received in good order by the Registrar and Transfer Agent prior to 1 p.m (Central European time) on the relevant Dealing Day. Redemption proceeds shall be paid in the relevant reference currency usually within one (1) Business Day following the relevant Dealing Day.

## How can I complain?
